FOUR OPTIONS FOR EDUCATION/DEGREE CRITERIA NECESSARY TO SIT FOR THE CPA EXAM IN UTAH:

(Education must include 150 semester (225 quarter) hours and must meet one of the four criteria below, as evidenced through submitting an official transcript)

- **Graduate degree in Accounting** from AACSB or ACBSP accredited program [R156-26a-302a(1)(a)(i)]
- **Masters of Business Administration** degree from an AACSB or ACBSP accredited program with not less than:
 - 24 semester (36 quarter) **upper division** hours [R156-26a-302a(1)(a)(ii)(A)] or
 - 15 semester (24 quarter) **graduate hours** [R156-26a-302a(1)(a)(ii)(B)] with at least one course in the following subjects: Financial Accounting, Auditing, Taxation, Management Accounting
 - An **equivalent combination of graduate and upper division accounting courses** [R156-26a-302a(1)(a)(ii)(C)] covering the subjects of financial accounting, auditing, taxation, and management accounting.
 - One hour of graduate level course work being equivalent to 1.6 hour of upper division course work
- **Baccalaureate degree in business or accounting** from an AACSB or ACBSP accredited program **and 30 semester (45 quarter) hours** beyond the requirements for a baccalaureate degree which includes not less than:
 - 16 semester (24 quarter) **upper division hours** in covering the subjects of financial accounting, auditing, taxation, and management accounting [R156-26a-302a-(1)(a)(iii)(A)].
 - Must have at least one course with a minimum of two semester (3 quarter) hours (when combined with the requirement below)
 - 8 semester (12 quarter) hours in **graduate level accounting courses** covering the subjects of financial accounting, auditing, taxation, and management accounting [R156-26a-302a-(1)(a)(iii)(B)].
 - Must have at least one course with a minimum of two semester (3 quarter) hours (when combined with the requirement above)
 - [R156-26a-302a-(1)(a)(iii)(B)].**upper division non-accounting business courses**
 - 12 semester (18 quarter) hours in **graduate level business or accounting courses**; AND
 - 10 semester (15 quarter) hours of **either graduate or upper division accounting or business courses**

- **Graduate or undergraduate program** from an institution accredited by Northwest Association of Schools and Colleges, Commission on Colleges, North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, Commission on Institutions of Higher Education, or equivalent accrediting institution (as determined by the State Board of Accountancy). [R156-26a-302a-(1)(b)].
 - **30 semester (45 quarter) hours in business or related courses providing a minimum of 2 semester (3 quarter) hours in each of the following subjects** [R156-26a-302a-(1)(b)(i)]:
 - Business law
 - Computers
 - Economics
 - Ethics
 - Finance
 - Statistics and quantitative methods
 - Written and oral communications; and
 - Business administration such as marketing, production, management, policy or organizational behavior
 - **24 semester (36 quarter) hours in upper division accounting courses with a minimum of 2 semester (3 quarter) hours in each of the following subjects:** [R156-26a-302a-(1)(b)(ii)]
 - Auditing
 - Finance
 - Managerial or cost accounting
 - Systems
 - Taxes
 - **30 semester (45 quarter) hours beyond the requirements for a baccalaureate degree of additional business related course work including not less than:** [R156-26a-302a-(1)(b)(iii)]
 - 8 semester (12 quarter) hours in graduate accounting courses
 - 12 semester (18 quarter) hours in graduate accounting or graduate business courses; AND
 - 10 semester (15 quarter) upper hours of division undergraduate or graduate level additional business related courses
